

Transplanting curricula and rejuvenating premedical courses at Weill Cornell Medicine-Qatar

Partnering with the Qatar Foundation for Education, Science and Community Development, Weill Cornell Medicine opened its doors in Qatar in the summer of 2002, then beginning the sequential deployment of a Cornell undergraduate two-year Premedical Program, followed by the Weill Cornell four-year Medical Program.
